


THE NORTHERN TOWER

The Northern Tower is a prominent roadside retail and leisure scheme anchored by Lidi and just a few minutes walk from Retford town centre. The Northern Tower is part of a wider regeneration project that will create over 400 jobs further bolstering the affluent, vibrant and attractive market town in North Nottinghamshire. The scheme will total approx. 50,000sq ft (4,600 sq m) with 162 parking spaces.












